Where a track grading is provided through either a landowner (e.g. NPWS) or an organisation like WildWalks, that Grade must be used. Note that WildWalks often provides grades for sections of walks

In situations where a walk is not graded or a section of a graded track is being used, the track grading table is provided to support NSW Bushwalking Guides providing a Grade. For Ungraded tracks, Leaders can request the support of a Guide familiar with the local area to provide a Grade for the proposed bushwalk using the table above. The proposed Grade needs to be approved by the Regional Commissioner
